

Joining a Zoom Meeting with Web Browser

Google Chrome

1. Open Chrome.
 2. Go to join.zoom.us.
 3. Enter your meeting ID provided by the host/organizer.
 4. Click **Join**.
- If this is your first time joining from Google Chrome, you will be asked to open the Zoom client to join the meeting.
 - You can check **Always open these types of links in the associated app** to skip this step in the future.
 - Click **Open Zoom Meetings** (PC) or **Open zoom.us** (Mac).

Safari

1. Open Safari.
2. Go to join.zoom.us.
3. Enter your meeting ID provided by the host/organizer.
4. Click **Join**.
5. When asked if you want to open zoom.us, click **Allow**.

Microsoft Edge or Internet Explorer

1. Open Edge or Internet Explorer.
2. Go to join.zoom.us.
3. Enter your meeting ID provided by the host/organizer.
4. Click **Join**.

Mozilla Firefox

1. Open Firefox.
 2. Go to join.zoom.us.
 3. Enter your meeting ID provided by the host/organizer.
 4. Click **Join**.
- If this is your first time joining from Firefox, you may be asked to open Zoom or the Zoom installer package.
 - To skip this step in the future, check **Remember my choice for zoommtg links**.
 - Click **Open Link**.

Joining a Meeting with Zoom Desktop Client (Zoom Application)

1. Open the Zoom desktop client.
2. Join a meeting using one of these methods:
 - Click **Join a Meeting** if you want to join without signing in.
3. Enter the meeting ID number and your display name.
 - If you're signed in, change your name if you don't want your default name to appear.
 - If you're not signed in, enter a display name.
4. Select if you would like to connect audio and/or video and click **Join**.

System requirements

- An internet connection – broadband wired or wireless (3G or 4G/LTE)
- Speakers and a microphone – built-in or USB plug-in or wireless Bluetooth
- A webcam or HD webcam - built-in or USB plug-in. (Or, a HD cam or HD camcorder with video capture card).

GHC2020 General rules

- You can connect using different devices. However, you should know that a personal computer has a more stable signal.
- Make sure you have a good and stable internet connection.
- Use earphone.
- Test ZOOM in advance. Rehearsal session will be active on 31 Aug, 14:00 - 16:00 (Rome Time).
- Join the meeting by entering your Name and Surname, followed by your conference ID (i.e., Albert Einstein, 999).
- Connect 15' before your presentation.
- Mute your phone.
- If a speaker does not show up at his/her presentation time, the Session Chair will move to the next presentation.
- There will be a break of 15' between sessions.
- On 4th September you will be able to download your Participation Certificate by logging into your registered account.
